1. Welcome and prayers

3. Minutes of the last meeting

5. Treasurers report

Robert Haydock, treasurer, reported there was £1,035.50 in the account and £649.94 in a special account.

6. Update on groups

Furniture scheme – (fuller report attached). The floor to the van has now been repaired. Costs have been met by the Rotary Club. Volunteer needed in the future to replace existing co-ordinator plus two driver volunteers are also needed. Lancashire County Council have given the scheme $\pounds169$ recognising that goods have been recycled rather than going to the dump.

Tools for self reliance – No report

One voice choir – The choir continue to practice weekly and have event at St Mary's on 4th April.

Credit union – Rev Dave Coaker reports the CU has two to three people each week coming in for loans and six people are currently paying into it. There are enough volunteers but always room for more and the scheme is going well.

Food bank – (fuller report attached). Food bank is open Monday to Friday. 10.00am to 12.00noon and Saturday and Sunday 12.00pm to 1.00pm. More food is needed as is publicity for the need for food.

- 2. An open letter to local supermarkets asking them if they have any ideas as to how they can support the food bank.
- 3. Letter to the Guardian publishing the foodbank.
